

Leaving Denmark – Things to remember

There are several authorities you need to inform upon departure, if you leave Denmark (holidays excepted) you must inform the authorities. This must be done online, if you have a NemID.

If you do not have a NemID, you must contact your local citizen service, register your departure and give back your health insurance card.

At www.lifeindenmark.dk – Leaving Denmark you will find links and information about the following:

- **CPR – Folkeregister – deregister your address from the national register**
The limit for notification is 5 days and you will be fined if you do not respect this time limit.
Remember to destroy your health insurance card.
- Post Nord
- Moving to a Nordic country
- National health insurance card
- Deregister children from nursery, kindergarten and school
- Read and report your electricity and heating consumption
- Bank and insurance
- How to take pension with you
- **Remember to notify SKAT (Danish Customs and Tax Administration)**
- Termination of a lease and reimbursement
- Holiday allowance - Claim your holiday allowance
- Your car – refund if you leave Denmark
- Car deregistration

International social security

When you leave the country you are no longer covered by the Danish Social Security. In some cases you may fully or partially retain or obtain the right to Danish social security while working abroad. But you must meet certain conditions depending on which country you work in. For more information, please contact
